Combat Veterans Motorcycle organization is open to all verified combat veterans that meet specific criteria and successfully complete a probationary period.

Who is Qualified?

All combat veterans, regardless of service or country of origin who are interested in serving their communities and having a fellowship of motorcycle enthusiasts.

All applicants must provide a DD214 or equivalent as proof of combat service.

All applicants must own a motorcycle capable of maintaining posted highway speeds (500cc minimum), and have a current motorcycle endorsement on his/her drivers license.

All applicants are subject to a probationary period of nine months during which time riding skills and interest will be evaluated. All meetings must be attended during this probationary period.
