Combat Veterans International is a diverse group of combat veterans whose mission is to help other veterans and their families.

CVI Chapter 11 members are located throughout Jefferson and Clallum counties. Our chapter members have elected to support a scholarship for eligible students who are selected by our Scholarship Committee during their initial year of study. Each \$500 award will be paid directly to the institution the student will attend.

Our scholarship will be awarded on the following criteria:

1. The student must be a child of a US Veteran.
2. The student submits a 250 word theme paper describing "The Responsibilities of a US Citizen."
3. The student must be accepted into an accredited university, college or trade school.
4. The student practices an awareness of citizenship and social responsibility.
5. A Letter of Recommendation from a US Veteran who knows the Scholarship applicant.

Members of the CVI Chapter 11 scholarship committee will review the theme papers and select the successful applicants by the end of the school year. We encourage students to seek opinions from teachers, counselors, parents and peers while writing about their responsibilities as a US citizen.
